ORDINANCE 2023/ - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DEERFIELD BEACH, FLORIDA, ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CITY BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2023; APPROVING VARIOUS DEPARTMENTAL BUDGET TRANSFERS WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND, AS SET FORTH IN EXHIBIT "A"; APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS TO THE BUILDING**

SERVICES FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$411,384, THE HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$140,540, AND THE STATE HOUSING INITIATIVE PROGRAM FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$230,559, AND REDUCING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUND BY \$116,199, AS SET FORTH IN EXHIBIT “A”; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
