- 1. Resolution 2024/021 - A Resolution of the City Commission of the City of Deerfield Beach, Florida, approving a parking license agreement with Beefree, LLC d/b/a Freebee for the use of five parking spaces at the Fire Rescue Station located at 928 E. Hillsboro Blvd. for charging, parking and storage of electric vehicles used to provide on-demand rideshare services within the City's Community Redevelopment Area; authorizing execution of the License Agreement; providing for severability, implementation and an effective date.**

The Resolution was read by title only.

David Santucci, City Manager, explained that as part of the Freebee rideshare service, a location is needed to park the vehicles when they are not in service, whereby, when the vehicles are in service, the drivers will

park their personal vehicles in the same location. Thereafter, a photograph of the location was displayed, which will be Fire Station 4, as it is an underutilized parking area.

In response to Mayor Ganz's questions, Mr. Santucci replied that the parking is for firefighters and city employees, but they do not park in this specific area; they mainly park in front of the building. Further, he said portions of the Police Athletic League (PAL) will be moved to the Tigner Center. Lastly, there will not be any overflow issues.

Mayor Ganz opened the public hearing; however, there were none to speak and the public hearing was closed.
