ORDINANCE 2021/ - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF DEERFIELD BEACH, FLORIDA, ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CITY BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2021; APPROVING DEPARTMENTAL BUDGET TRANSFERS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,543,000 WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND; APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$63,885 FOR THE NUISANCE ABATEMENT FUND, AND APPROPRIATING THE LOAN PROCEEDS FROM FUND BALANCE OF THE ENERGY PERFORMANCE PROJECT FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,829,000; APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS TO THE CRIME PREVENTION FUND FOR THE \$7,350 PRIVATE CONTRIBUTION RECEIVED BY THE CITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**
